









# Summer Curriculum Overview – Year 3

 <h2>English</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write a suspense story inspired by 'Wolves in the Walls' by Neil Gaiman</li> <li>Compose a holiday brochure using the non fiction book 'Skara Brae' as inspiration</li> <li>Explore the poem 'I asked the little boy who couldn't see' and then write a poem</li> <li>Consolidate VIPERS skills through reading comprehensions related to class text.</li> </ul> <p><b>To support your child with this aspect of their learning you could:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to enjoy reading a full range of genre at home daily</li> <li>Pick out interesting vocabulary the author has used</li> <li>Encourage your child to read with expression</li> <li>Ask comprehension questions requiring a deeper level of understanding (How do you think the character felt? How would you feel if you were the character?  <h2>Maths</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identifying right angles</li> <li>Identifying and drawing parallel and perpendicular lines</li> <li>Classifying and comparing 2D and 3D shapes</li> <li>Measuring perimeter</li> <li>Reading scales with different intervals in mass and volume</li> <li>Weigh and compare masses and capacities with mixed units</li> <li>One step problems in multiplication</li> <li>Order and compare numbers beyond 1000</li> </ul> <p><b>To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to practice the 4 mathematical calculations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)</li> <li>Ask quick fire times table questions to practise 2,3,4,5,6,8 and 10 times tables</li> <li>Using scales and measuring jugs around the home</li> </ul>	 <h2>History/Geography</h2> <p><u>History</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Julius Caesar's attempted invasion in 55-54 BC</li> <li>The Roman Empire by AD 42 and the power of its army</li> <li>successful invasion by Claudius and conquest, including Hadrian's Wall</li> <li>British resistance, for example, Boudica</li> <li>'Romanisation' of Britain: sites such as Caerwent and the impact of technology, culture and beliefs, including early Christianity</li> </ul> <p><u>Geography</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use maps to observe the growth of the Roman Empire across Europe and the wider world</li> </ul>	 <h2>Art/D&amp;T</h2> <p><u>ART</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Exploring mosaics – colours, patterns and themes</li> <li>Understand the genre of botanical art</li> <li>Natural weaving</li> <li>Colour prints</li> <li>Detailed botanical painting of fruit</li> </ul> <p><u>DT</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Design and make a greenhouse using a range of tools and equipment.</li> <li>Analyse and Evaluate designs.</li> </ul> <p><b>Music/French (KS2)</b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learn a disco song called 'Bringing us together'</li> <li>History of music</li> <li>Pets</li> <li>animals</li> </ul>
