## YEAR 6

Year 6 have been thrown straight into 'Distortion and Abstraction' in their new art learning this week, exploring how to manipulate a simple image by cutting it up and rearranging the pieces. The children loved the creativity of the task, exploring different ways of presenting their learning.

The children also shared their opinions with pupil voice, with one child expressing how some art pieces 'hurts her brain'!
