YEAR 1

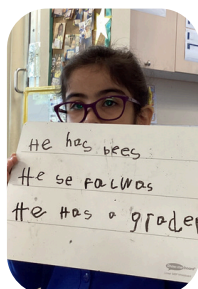
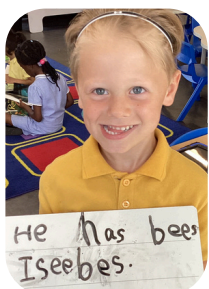
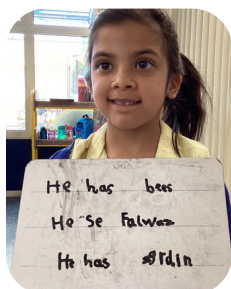

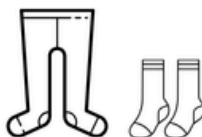


Plain navy trousers
