
Percentage of Pupils Working at a Higher Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths








Percentage of Pupils Working at or Above the Reading Standard






Comparison of pupils working at a higher standard of reading at Martins Wood Primary School for 2022


Percentage of Pupils Working at a Higher Standard in Maths









Comparison of pupils working at a higher standard in maths at Martins Wood Primary School for 2022


Comparison of pupils working at a higher standard in grammar, punctuation and spelling standards at Martins Wood Primary School for 2022


