Year 4 - Science

The children in year 4 have been investigating whether toothpaste is effective at protecting teeth. They used eggs to represent their teeth and put these into different liquids. One egg was covered in toothpaste and one wasn't. They have observed that the eggs that were covered with toothpaste were protected from staining and decay.



Football

The Year 5/6 Football team played in the final of the Tournament last week. They battled hard, drawing twice and losing once, but didn't manage to make it any further on this occasion. Well done to all the children involved!



Reception

Reception have been learning about repeating patterns in their Maths lessons. They have been creating patterns using different resources including their bodies. They explored simple, 2 item patterns (red, blue, red, blue) and more complex patterns with 3 and 4 items: red blue yellow; red blue yellow/ stamp stamp clap; stamp stamp clap/ square triangle circle for example. The children went on to look at the vocabulary around patterns, to recognise and confidently talk about the patterns they have seen and created.
