

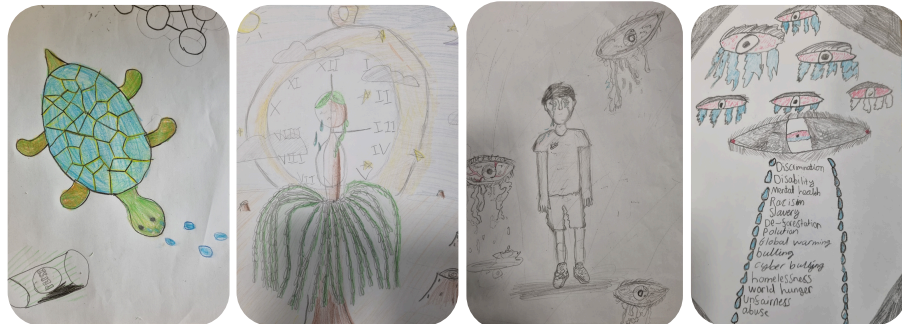

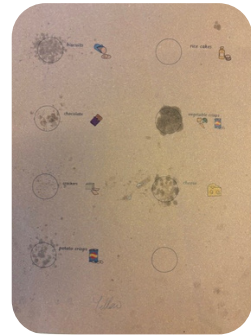
Nursery - Autumn
