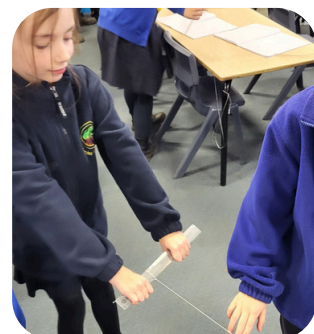
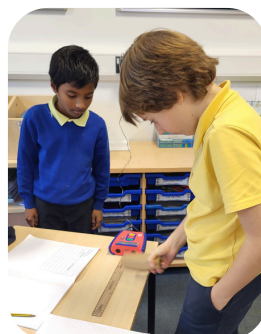

The children accessed activities that spanned all seven areas both prime and specific, kicking off Christmas, that magical time of the year for so many of us.



Year 4

In science, the Year 4 children have been investigating 'sound'. They explored volume by using different materials to muffle the sound and recorded the level of sound produced (decibels) using the log boxes. They then went on to investigate how pitch can be changed. Just like a stringed instrument, they changed the length and tightness of the string and discovered how this changed the pitch of the sound produced.



Year 3

As part of Year 3's Animal Nutrition and the Skeletal System topic, we investigated if people with longer arms can throw longer distances or if people with longer legs can jump further.
