We are excited to share that our Motor Skills Development sessions for parents and carers in Hertfordshire are continuing into 2025!

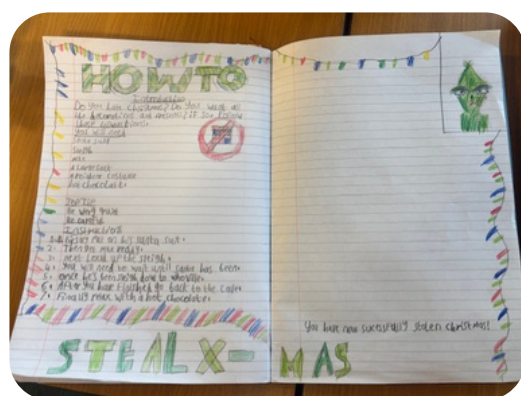
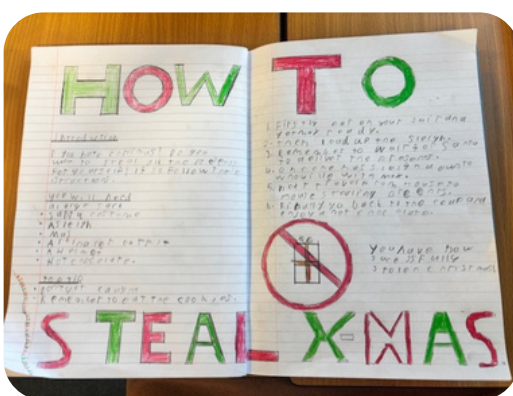
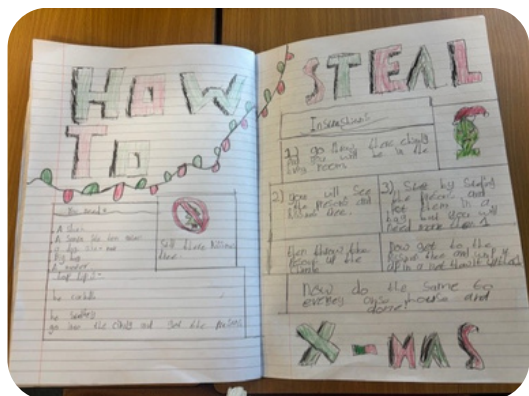
