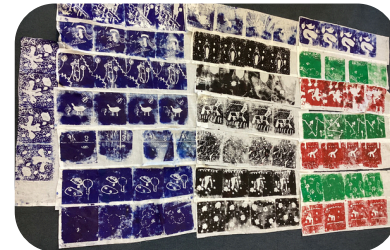
RECEPTION
