We are incredibly proud of how the children behaved so respectfully and showed such wonderful care and curiosity throughout the visit.



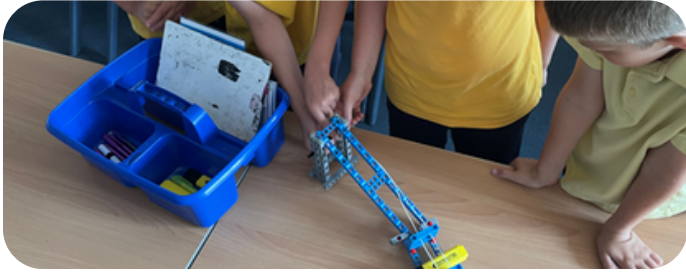
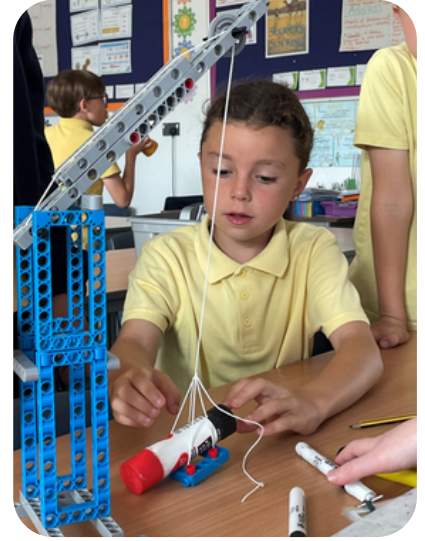
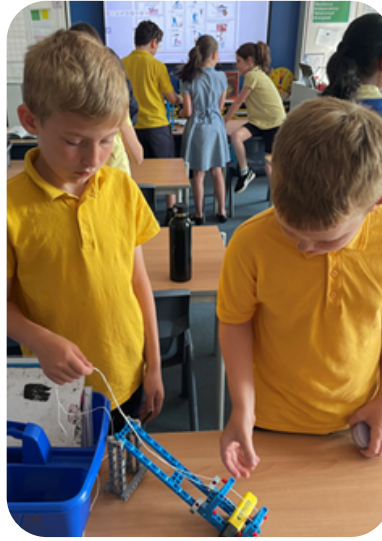
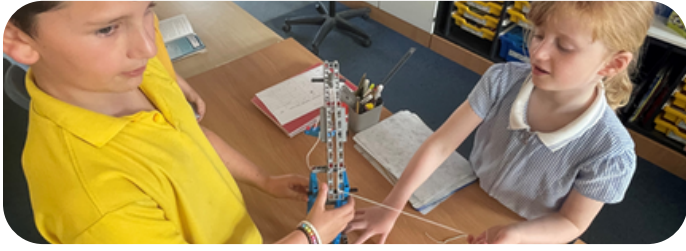
YEAR 2
