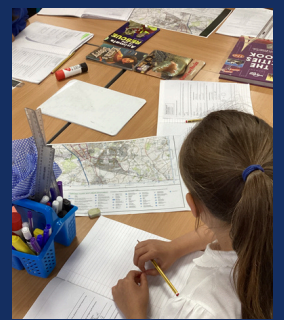
SAPLINGS
