YEAR 2

This week Year 2 have been busy experimenting in Science and investigating good hand hygiene. The children used shiny glitter as a substitute for 'germs' and investigated what would work best to remove the germs fully - cold water, soap and cold water or soap and warm water? The children were amazed to see how quickly the germs could spread around the classroom as specks of glitter began to appear in places they didn't actively touch. This really helped the children to solidify their understanding of good hand hygiene. In RE this week the children have been learning about the Christian season of Advent and its importance. The children made their own advent wreaths and discussed the meanings of the advent candles.

YEAR 6

In Year 6 this week, the children have been learning about the different components that make up blood. They have created their own representation of a blood sample using household ingredients. The children mixed them together and watched them separate into their different parts: plasma, white blood cells, red blood cells and platelets.
