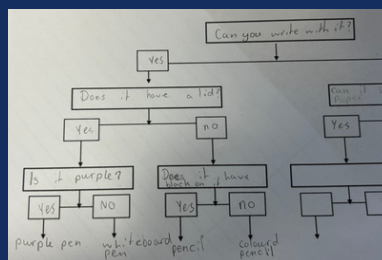
YEAR 1
