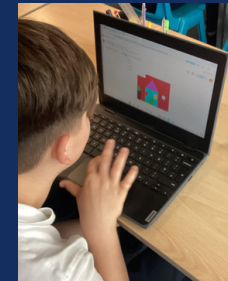
RECEPTION
