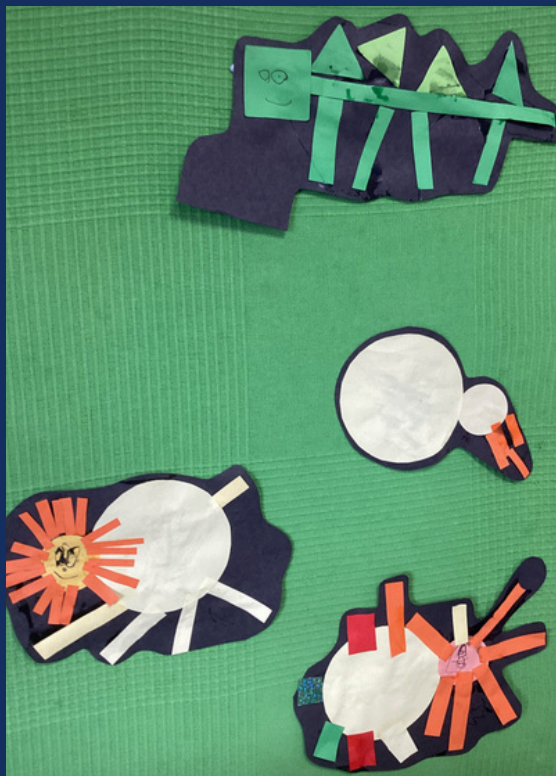
## SAPLINGS

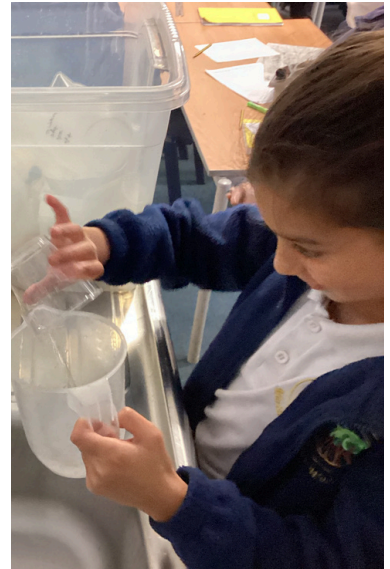
